Notes on all tables

- Last class date 1998 to 2001. If offender enrolled more than once in program, reoffenses after the *earliest* program termination date were used.
- Men’s program only.
- Reoffenses included arrests, non-arrests, citations and protection orders, occurring between last class date and 12/31/03. Only protection orders granted are included (“date protection order granted” field is not null).
- Reoffenses limited to intimate partner victim, or relationship unknown.
