Overview of The Duluth Family Parenting Time Center

The Duluth Family Parenting Time Center (DFPTC) provides a safe place that is free from domestic violence where children can build and maintain positive relationships with their parents.

Position Summary

DAIP is seeking a Part-Time Parenting Time Specialist to primarily serve as an observer and monitor of regularly scheduled supervised parenting time and of safe exchanges families enrolled in the Duluth Family Parenting Time Center. The Parenting Time Specialist builds relationships with families that foster trust, safety, and reliability and serves as a guiding example of how to nurture nonviolent relationships and communication.

Key Responsibilities

- Assist with and observe parenting time and exchanges;
- Protect the safety, confidentiality, and well-being of adult victims of domestic violence and their children;
- Provide supportive interventions before, during, and after visits/exchanges;
- Provide a safe, healthy, nurturing, and clean environment for children and their caregivers; and
- Support day-to-day program operations and administrative tasks.

Benefits: Eligible for Earned Sick and Safe Time (ESST) and immediate participation in DAIP's retirement plan. DAIP employer contributions begin after an employee works more than 1,000 hours within a 12-month period.

Physical Demands: ability to lift and carry items (typically up to 10–40 pounds), ability to sit, stand, walk, for extended periods during supervised visits and exchanges; ability to lift and carry up to 20–25 pounds occasionally, such as children's supplies, toys, files, or equipment; ability to bend, stoop, reach, kneel, and crouch when interacting with children or retrieving materials.
